Reading/Writing – We will continue with Predicting, Recall, Characters, Inferring, and connecting with texts. I love the student's writing in each of these areas.

Math – subtraction, tally charts, picture graphs, bar graphs, and money

Science – learn all about pumpkins, making of bread, how butter is made, and our senses

Social Studies – Columbus and how we fit into the world
